All scholarships will be awarded based on Merit and all intended majors including undecided will be considered. One scholarship will be set-aside for a qualifying student who will be attending a Historically Black College or University (HBCU).

Tommy Benford Jr. "Faith" Scholarship

Tommy Benford Jr., husband of Soror Marilyn Crawford-Brooks, was an East Bay singer, musician, and artist. Tommy had a sincere commitment to support underprivileged African American/Black students in their journey to a collegiate experience in the Arts. This scholarship is to support and to grow the number of underrepresented students pursuing a degree in the Arts. The Arts include music, dance, painting, sculpture, theater, and literature. This scholarship and a little "faith" will allow a deserving student the opportunity to pursue their artistic dreams.

Eligibility Requirements

- Graduating Senior • GPA of at least 2.50 on a 4.00 scale
- Be an African American male or female student
- Have a "Declared Intention" to enroll in an accredited 2 or 4-year college or university in the 2023-2024 academic year.
- Applicant must be a resident of Contra Costa /Alameda County, have financial need, and demonstrate artistic talent

Required Application Documents

- 1) An **OFFICIAL** school transcript with cumulative grade point average to be emailed to scholarship@aka-ruo.com by a school administrator.
- 2) **Two** (2) Letters of Recommendation (One from your school and one from the community)
 - o **CANNOT** be friends or family members
 - o Letters **MUST** be dated and contain the writer's contact information
- 3) An Essay: (Must be a minimum of 2 full pages, but not more than 3 pages, typed and double spaced, 12pt. font and 1in. margins on all sides). Please tell us what you plan to do with your degree once you graduate.

Rho Upsilon Omega Academic Scholarships

Rho Upsilon Omega Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. was chartered May 6th, 1989. Alpha Kappa Alpha, Sorority, Inc. is the world's oldest college-based sorority founded by African American women. Its purpose is to "cultivate and encourage high scholastic and ethical standards" and to "serve all mankind". Rho Upsilon Omega is an active chapter working together to serve the Southern Alameda and Contra Costa Counties of California.

Eligibility Requirements

- *Demonstrate leadership abilities through participation in community service, extracurricular or other activities.*
- *Be a High School Senior. (Must have full-time status in an accredited high school)*
- *Be in good academic standing. (Minimum 2.6 GPA based on a 4.0 scale)*
- *Have a "Declared Intention" to enroll in an accredited four-year college or university in the Fall of 2023 [NOTE: Proof of enrollment will be required prior to the disbursement of funds.]*

Selection

*Applicants will be selected as finalists based on academic accomplishments, and other requirements as outlined. Finalists will be required to participate in a 30-minute virtual interview. If needed, the scholarship committee may contact eligible applicants for additional information. Successful applicant(s) will be notified on or before May 1, 2023. **If you are selected as an award recipient, your presence will be required at a recognition event to be held in June 2023.***

Application Deadline

The online application and ALL required documentation must be submitted no later than 5pm on Saturday, April 15, 2023.
